# Lamar FFA Creative Arts Show Rules & Regulations

### **RULE 1: GOVERNING RULES**

All entries and awards are subject to the General Rules of the Lamar FFA Show & Auction. All Rules must be adhered to or the project will be disqualified. Please read all the rules before proceeding.

# **RULE 2: APPLICATION FOR ENTRY**

All Entries must be entered by the due date. Forms not completely filled out will not be accepted and the entry fee will be forfeited.

RULE 3: ALL CULINARY ARTS ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED BY MONDAY, APRIL 15<sup>TH</sup>, 2024, TO MS. INFANTE(J112) OR CHEF BLAYLOCK.

# **RULE 4: ELIGIBILITY**

All Lamar students are eligible to participate in the show **if** they are meeting all UIL eligibility standards at the time of the show. Students will be required to submit an eligibility form at check-in for verification.

**RULE 5: ENTRY FEES** The entry fee is \$10.00 *per* entry, which is due **WITH** show entry form, on April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Only one entry per show, per exhibitor is allowed.

# **RULE 6: EXHIBIT ENTRIES AT SHOW**

All Culinary Arts Show entries are to be checked in between 3:00 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2024, **IN THE CULIARY ROOM.** NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED BEFORE OR AFTER THIS DATE AND TIME.

# **RULE 7: ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

- A. All entries must be made by one individual and only by the person whose name appears on the entry card. **Projects made by groups or organizations will not be accepted.**
- B. ONLY one entry will be accepted in each Show. Two entries for the same show will NOT be accepted.
- C. EVERY EXHIBITOR is required to submit an eligibility form for each entry. One original form may be used, and copies of that form will be accepted as long as the original is on file with the Show coordinators. PLEASE HAVE A COPY OF THIS FORM AVAILABLE DURING CHECK-IN.

# **RULE 8: REGISTRATION COMMITTEE**

The registration committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry depending on conditions and suitability for exhibit. The committee has the right to reclassify any exhibit. Entries will be exhibited subject to available space at the discretion of the Show Superintendent.

# **RULE 9: JUDGING**

Judging will be done by highly qualified judges whose decision will be final. Committee Members will not be eligible to judge or work in the Show in which they or their children are exhibiting. Each show will be judged by Class. Ribbons will be given. **Judging will be closed to the public; exhibitors cannot be present during the judging.** 

# **RULE 10: AWARDS**

- A. Ribbons will be awarded to all participants.
- B. Best of Show ribbons will be awarded in each Class

# CULINARY ARTS SHOW SPECIAL RULES

# **RULE 1: ENTRIES**

Entry forms will be accepted for the following Classes: (DUE April 15, 2024) For Information and entry forms, contact; Ms. Infante in J112 or Chef Blaylock.

**CLASS 1: COOKIES** - Suggested entries: bar cookies, drop, rolled, cut out, brownies, etc.

### **RULE 2: RECIPES**

For judging purposes, all food entries **MUST** be accompanied by a typed or printed **ORIGINAL** recipe on a 5x7, or smaller, index card attached to the item. Title of Entry & recipe must be on the front of the card and **EXHIBITOR NAME ON THE BACK OF THE CARD.** 

# **RULE 3: CONTAINERS**

Entries MUST be displayed on disposable display and covered with a see-through top (plastic wrap securely fastened, etc.). **ABSOLUTELY NO CONTAINERS WILL BE RETURNED.** 

# **RULE 4: FOOD SAFETY**

Food entries must **NOT NEED REFRIGERATION** before consumption. Items must be made according to general Food Safety guidelines and must not require special accommodations before judged. Items can potentially be left at room temperature for a few hours before being judged. All leftovers from judging will be thrown away.

# **RULE 5: SIZE**

The entry must contain a minimum of six (6) and a maximum of a dozen (12) cookies total.

### **RULE 6: PROJECT REPORT**

A diary/report, with pictures, must accompany all entries and must be signed by a Lamar FFA Advisor, Registration Committee member, or Show Superintendent. A **minimum of five (5) photos** showing different stages of the project must be included. Diary/report format will be provided by the Superintendent in advance to the show. ALL FOOD ENTRIES MUST BE MADE BY THE EXHIBITOR, AND DISPLAY ORIGINALITY. (Ingredients can be duplicated, but directions & Baking report/diary must be of exhibitors ORIGINAL MAKING).

# **RULE 7: AUCTION**

Food items from this contest will **NOT** be sold in the Lamar FFA Livestock Show and Auction.

# **RULE 8: CHECK-IN**

All Culinary Show entries are to be checked in between 3:00 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2024 **IN THE CULINARY ROOM.** The judging will begin promptly at 5:00 PM.
